

These last twelve years serving at both parishes has had its demands, but the rewards far outweigh everything else.

On July 1, 2024, I will be retiring from active ministry at both parishes and Geri and I will begin a new chapter as we look forward to travel and spending winters in a warmer climate. After our accident a year ago, it has become more challenging both emotionally and physically to drive into town one, two or three times a week.

We will both be exploring ways to become involved in our NEW parish in Huron, and I will look at ways I may assist in Huron and Florida.

We ask for your prayers on this next journey. Know that we will always keep you in our prayers.
