GOSPEL MEDITATION:

One of the most touching YouTube videos I've ever seen is one in which a deaf woman receives new technology to heal her hearing. She hears her husband's voice for the first time — and her own, too — and bursts into tears of overwhelming joy. It must have been like an immovable wall between her and her loved ones came tumbling down.

We are all like this woman, to some degree. We believe in the presence of God's love, but we can't hear Him. We can't speak well about Him. The deaf man who can't speak properly in the Gospel today is an image of what God wants us to experience again and again. Jesus takes the man aside to a private place away from the crowd, touches his ears and tongue, and says, "Ephphata!" The man's ears are opened, and he speaks clearly.

Contact with Christ has this effect on us. This experience happens to us in our baptism, almost exactly. It happens to us in the liturgy. It happens in our private prayer. It happens when we hear the voice of God in our conscience. The more we engage these privileged channels of Jesus' healing, the more we are empowered to hear and speak of the presence of God's perfect love.

Building a Home for Coralia

Last year, when Fr. Kevin and the St. Luke El Salvador Ministry team visited El Salvador, they were deeply moved by the extreme poverty they witnessed. One of the most impactful encounters was with Coralia, a 74-year-old widow living alone in a home that can hardly be called a shelter. In the photo to the above, you can see Coralia's current home—made of sticks and corrugated metal, perched dangerously on a steep hill. When it rains, water floods through the bare earth floor. Without a bed she is forced to sleep on a bed of sticks to stay off the ground. Despite these harsh conditions, Coralia's faith shines brightly. She walks an hour each way, twice a week, to attend church services, her devotion undiminished by the challenges she faces daily. Coralia relies on her neighbors for food, as she lives without the basic necessities most of us take for granted. Moved by her plight, Fr. Kevin challenged our ministry team, to work with the St. Dominic El Salvador Ministry to build her a new home—a place where she can live with dignity and safety. The new home, now under construction will be a significant improvement over her current conditions. The photos below show the progress on her new one. This transformation is made possible through the hard work of the St. Luke El Salvador Team and the generosity of a few donors. Your prayers and support are making a profound difference in Coralia's life, and the community we are serving in El Salvador. As we continue this mission, we ask for your continued prayers and support. Together, we can provide Coralia—and others like her—with the safety, dignity, and hope they deserve.
