

Gospel Meditation

Americans have long been fascinated with public debates. Farmers stood in muddy fields for hours to hear Lincoln and Douglas dispute each other in the 1860 presidential run-up. The televised debate

between Kennedy and Nixon in 1960 fascinated the nation. These days, cable news outlets and social media parse every word spoken by candidates. We still love seeing public, rational disputes in the service of our nation.

In his day, Jesus also captured attention as a public debater. Mark tells us, "And one of the scribes came up and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, asked him, 'Which commandment is the first of all?'" Jesus' brief but all-encompassing response is the double command to love God and neighbor. Notice that he includes the importance of loving God with "all your mind." Loving God is not simply a question of affection, loyalty, good deeds, and religious dedication. It demands honest and intense intellectual engagement — just like an accomplished debater.

How do we do this practically? One simple way is by embracing ourselves as life-long learners. Setting aside time for reading, book studies, online classes, and, perhaps most difficult, engaging in open, honest, and curious conversation with those who think differently from us. These are all great ways to love God with our minds. Our country and our Church depend greatly on souls who love God in this way with their minds. Let's commit to loving God with all our minds in tireless pursuit of truth.

Congratulations to Mr. Sean Homey

Sean, a seminarian from St. James Parish for the Diocese of Cleveland, was installed in the ministry of lector on October 25 at St. Mary Seminary by Bishop Malesic. The formal installation of a lector is distinct from the role of parishioners who serve as lectors and proclaim the Word of God at Mass on Sundays. Being instituted as a lector is one of the key steps in a seminarian's journey toward ordination to the priesthood. This ministry has its roots in the early Church, where minor orders played a significant role in preparing men for the priesthood. Historically, minor orders included roles such as porter, exorcist, acolyte, and lector. However, in 1972, Pope Paul VI issued Ministeria Quaedam, which reorganized these roles, suppressing some minor orders and establishing the ministries of lector and acolyte as formal, lay ministries. As an instituted lector, Sean has received a specific mandate to study, live, and proclaim the Word of God within the liturgy. This ministry calls for a deep dedication to Scripture study, as lectors not only read but embody the Word, bringing it to life for the faithful. The installation reflects his dedication to the journey of faith and prepares him for more profound responsibilities in service to the Church.

Best Recipes for Thanksgiving

With Thanksgiving just around the corner, I've been on a search to try and find the best recipes for Thanksgiving. So for consideration, I offer you this recipe for, *The very best most excellent Pecan Pie*.

Makes 8 to 10 servings

Active time: 10 minutes Total time: 55 minutes

Ingredients

1 refrigerated pie crust, room temperature

2 cups (packed) dark brown sugar

4 large eggs

1/4 cup (1/2 stick) unsalted butter, melted

1 tablespoon Scotch whisky, or higher proof bourbon

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon

2 cups pecan halves

Whipped cream

Directions

Preheat oven to 350°F. Line 9-inch glass pie dish with dough. Crimp edge decoratively. Whisk sugar, eggs, butter, Scotch/Bourbon, vanilla, and cinnamon in large bowl to blend. Mix in nuts. Pour filling into dough-lined dish.

Bake pie until filling is slightly puffed and set in center of the oven, covering edges with foil if browning too quickly, about 40 minutes. Cool pie completely at room temperature. Cut into wedges and serve with whipped cream.
